


Yu Hong was a Central Asian diplomat born in an era when cultural interactions thrived along the famed Silk Road. The Silk Road was a series of trade routes that covered over 6000 km from China to Europe.

These routes were important because traders and travellers helped spread ideas, culture, inventions and products across a vast area. Yu Hong was one of these travellers.

His sarcophagus (coffin) was discovered in northern China in 1999. The decorative carvings portray heroic stories and scenes of paradise. The marble panels were once brightly coloured, but have faded over time.
